Mosaic Christian Fellowship Seventh-day Adventist Church

- 1. Mosaic will be following all CDC guidelines in addition to all federal, state, local health official requirements, which also includes the recommendations from the Texas Conference of Seventh-day Adventists (TCSDA). - 2. All at risk people groups to remain home and continue attending Mosaic remotely via online live stream.
- 3. Everyone who plans to attend in-person shall self-screen and self-monitor before coming to the church site. This includes, but not limited to, checking your temperature to be below 100 degrees, and if anyone has any symptoms, please remain at home. Symptoms include: cough, difficulty breathing, chills and shaking, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, temperature of 100 degrees or above.
- 4. Strongly encourage the use of face masks when inside the building, unless speaking or singing from up front.
 - 4.1. <u>Facemasks will be available for those who attend</u> without them.
 - 4.2. First service (9:00 AM-10:00 AM) will be facemask mandatory.
 - 4.3. Second service (11:10 AM-12:20 PM) will be facemask recommended.
- 5. Everyone is encouraged to observe the six (6') feet social distancing.

- 6. Signage will be placed throughout the church reminding people to wear masks, maintain social distance, and observe the sanctuary-seating plan as outlined.
- 7. Hand sanitizer made available throughout the building.
- 8. Every other row designated seating in the sanctuary, keeping one empty row between rows for seating, and to ask those not attending together as a family to keep at least 2 seats or 6 feet of space between them.
- 9. We are encouraging people who have potential of high communicative exposure (although not currently symptomatic, to worship with us via our online live stream services.
- 10. We will continue our usual two (2) worship services at our regular times to allow for social distance management.
- 11. Adult SS will continue as our panel discussion in the sanctuary via live stream service with no other SS classes (adult or children) meeting until further notice.
- 12. Fellowship hall will be available for overflow.
- 13. All regular hard surfaces disinfect regularly.
 - 13.1. Our facility will be disinfected prior to use.
 - 13.2. Provide cleaning products at the end of each service so worshippers can volunteer to help with that.
- 14. Single entrance only. Use the church's front entrance only. All other entrances will not be in use.
- 15. Tithe and offerings will be collected at the back doors of our sanctuary. Offering plates will not be passed. Deacons and

- deaconesses to hold offering bags at sanctuary doors instead of passing them person—to—person.
- 16. Bulletins will be accessible on our website (mosaicsda.org) for viewing/downloading and will be available on paper 06/20/2020 but will not be distributed at the entry door.
- 17. Each person or family is encouraged to evaluate and decide for himself/herself what is best for them and their families in terms of when they decide to return to church in person.
- 18. Please remember, being at church is a voluntary choice and we are committed to making it both safe and pleasant for people as possible. This means we will be flexible, non–judgmental with people, and respect everyone's individual choices.
- 19. Everyone is highly encouraged to observe all the recommended guidelines but we will not enforce them on people unless there is a clear deliberate behavior that disrespects others and puts them at risk.
